## **General Instructions**

Everything sounds an octave higher. Circled numbers mean the following:

The bending is very legato, doing a glissando upwards from the G#, without a break.

The bending should end on an abrupt staccato.

Played with a lot of pressure from the diaphragm.

4 On the B natural (where the \* is placed), the flutist should kiss the embouchure, producing a high and resonant sound with some B intonation.

5 Same note position but pronouncing the letter "F".

6) Only frulatti.

7 The gesture of inhaling air should be exaggerated.

With the "F" sound the air is inhaled through the flute.

10) Only frulatti.

## **Other indications:**

(k) means the "K" sound produced by the throat to enhance the acttack. The U signs mean the inclination of the piccolo in relation to the mouth of the player.

 $\neq$  and  $\oint$  mean between i and # and between i and b respectively.

• "Bending" in the direction that it shows.

**f** frulatti.

"Whistle", a very soft harmonic that sounds like a quiet whistle.

T's" sound only, with frulatti, no pitch.



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
